

ConnLUG Safety and Wellness Policy

As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, ConnLUG has instituted new rules and regulations for our in-person events and gatherings. These rules are the direct representation of the feedback given by ConnLUG members who participated in the June 2020 survey. All ConnLUG members and guests are required to abide by these rules, in addition to all existing rules, guidelines, and organizational policies.

Safety and Wellness Rules:

1. In-person ConnLUG-hosted gatherings will resume for our standard Monthly Meeting according to the timetable and requirements set forth in the [Sector Rules for Reopen](#) guidelines found on the [State of Connecticut website](#).
2. ConnLUG members and guests who choose to attend in-person meetings once they resume are **REQUIRED** to take the following precautions for the safety and well-being of all in attendance:
 - a. ALL members and guests **MUST** wear a mask or face covering that completely covers their nose and mouth securely for the entire duration of all in-person gatherings.
 - b. ALL members and guests **MUST** wash their hands with soap and water upon arrival at any venue or location where scheduled gatherings will be held.
 - c. ALL members and guests **MUST** maintain a physical distance of 6 feet (2m) from all other members and guests during gatherings where practicable and whenever possible.
 - d. ALL members and guests **MUST** disclose to the Board of Directors if they have been ill or feverish during the two-week period that precedes scheduled in-person gatherings.
 - e. ALL members and guests **MUST STAY HOME** if they self-report to the Board of Directors that they have been ill or feverish during the two-week period that precedes scheduled in-person gatherings.
3. ConnLUG members and guests **MUST** leave their parts, sets, MOCs, building instructions, and other personally owned LEGO® products at home and not bring them to in-person gatherings.
4. Set drafts are discontinued until further notice.
5. Parts and minifigure swaps and trades are prohibited until further notice.
6. ConnLUG members and guests may observe set review sets but **MUST NOT** touch or come in contact with set review sets at in-person gatherings.
7. There will be no “public brick” or assorted parts for build challenges during in-person gatherings. Parts will not be shared among members during events.
8. All in-person gatherings can be joined remotely via live video calls for which remote meeting contact info will be published ahead of each meeting. The Summer Barbeque and Holiday Dinner will not be included.
9. ALL members and guests who cannot meet the above requirements or do not feel comfortable attending in-person gatherings now or in the future are asked to stay home and only join meetings remotely.
